However, they lost track of her until last month when they spotted her passing by the church gates. Delighted to see her again, they told her about an

event taking place on that Sunday which she attended. From then on, she started attending services in the church regularly.

They learnt that the young woman, named Favor, aged about 19 years old, had come to Lagos through a friend's promise of better opportunities in the big city. To her dismay, she discovered that the only job

open to her would be prostitution. Refusing to engage in such activities, she suffered physical and emotional abuse from her friend and was eventually thrown out onto the streets, where she slept on the stairs of a nearby bakery.

However, things changed when one of the church's assistants noticed job advertisements at the bakery where the young woman slept. They helped her apply for the job for which she was hired and started work. The bakery manager was touched by her story and promised to provide accommodation for her.

Interestingly, she had prior experience working in bakeries from her home village, which made it an ideal job for her. Before landing the bakery job, she survived by collecting plastic bottles on the streets to sell, but the income was insufficient for her basic needs.

Now, with a stable job and unexpected blessings, she plans to support herself and save money to visit her family back in her home village. The church members are delighted with the positive change in her life, considering she has only been attending church for a month.





Through further counselling and medical assessments, it was discovered that her family had been searching for her for over a year. Thanks to the efforts of a woman from her village, her family
