OVERCOMING ILLNESS WITH UNSHAKABLE FAITH

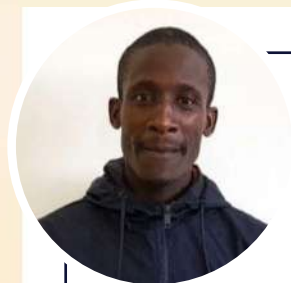

"I was raised by both my parents, although my upbringing had many challenging circumstances. I was sexually abused at the age of 12 and that experience threw my life into complete chaos. Subsequently, I experienced intense body pains and struggled to concentrate on my studies because of the mistreatment that followed.

Throughout my life, I felt trapped. I was afraid of going to school at times. Eventually, I made the difficult decision to drop out. Later on, I got married, and it was my husband who recognised my suffering and suggested that I seek help at the Universal Church. I started attending services on Sundays and Tuesdays for my healing and deliverance. I was fighting for my life to change but was not seeing any difference. I struggled to let go of what had happened in my past and that impeded my life from progressing.

A turning point happened one Sunday when the pastor called people with various sicknesses to the front for a prayer. Despite my doubts stemming from prolonged disappointment, I was encouraged by my husband to go to

the front. Because of his urging, I took a step forward and placed my hands where I felt the pain. Fuelled by my faith, I declared that I would be healed. Right after the prayer, I felt free and I realised that I had indeed been healed.

In the past, I grappled with anger and I had



a quick temper, but now I am a changed person and I am no longer imprisoned by my past. My marriage is blessed and we live in harmony," said Pascalina.
