“However, when He, the Spirit of truth, has come, He will guide you into all truth; for He will not speak on His own authority, but whatever He hears He will speak; and He will tell you things to come.” John 16:13.

If you keep lying to yourself, others, and God, how can He guide you? Many people claim to serve God but do not have His Spirit; it’s impossible to do one without having the other. IN A MOMENT OF TIME...

When the devil tempted Jesus, he made various proposals. For example, when Jesus had fasted for 40 days and was therefore very hungry, the devil said: *“If You are the Son of God, command this stone to become bread” Luke 4:3.*

The Lord Jesus could have performed this miracle, but had He done so, He would have done the devil’s will in that moment of time. And because of that fleeting moment, He would no longer be fit to be God’s perfect sacrifice for us, for He would have sinned.

In another attempt to make Jesus fall into temptation, the devil took Him to a high mountain and, in a moment of time, showed Him all the kingdoms of the world, and said, *“All this authority I will give You, and their glory; for this has been delivered to me, and I give it to whomever I wish. Therefore, if You will worship before me, all will be Yours.” Luke 4:6-7.*

The devil was audacious when he made a proposal of this nature to the Lord Jesus, who is the Son of God. The devil knows that he is the human being’s number one enemy; his primary mission is to destroy people in this world. That is why, at certain moments, he suggests, speaks, and inspires ideas in people’s

minds to make them deviate from God’s will. It is therefore very important to constantly pay attention to what the devil lays out before you, including praise, vanity, and ideas.

“Someone invited me to a stadium event and told me that my life would change. I had serious problems—I was drinking heavily, gambling, and even beating my girlfriend. I desperately needed help.

The Message That Changed Everything

It was the Amandla Ngawethu Event at the Ellis Park Stadium. I remember seeing the Bishop carrying a drum marked with a poison symbol.

He placed it down and pulled out papers with different “poisons”

labelled on them—anger, envy, and most strikingly for me, unforgiveness and hatred. He explained that unforgiveness is poison that kills you first, and referred to Matthew 6:14-15, which teaches how God won’t forgive us if we don’t forgive others.

A Decision to Change

This message struck me deeply because I was consumed by bitterness and anger. That day, I decided to change. I apologised to my girlfriend, asked her to forgive me, and spoke to her about my decision to put God first in my life.



A New Life

We started attending church together. I changed my ways, I decided to stop drinking and gambling. I gave attention to my family and no longer hit my girlfriend. My life was completely transformed. My girlfriend soon became my wife, and our children now share our faith.

I’m no longer a drunkard or an angry and bitter man. I’m a man of integrity and good character, who respects and cares for others. My family and I will be attending the Amandla Ngawethu Event together this year, and we are looking forward to it,” said Collen.

that was no longer enough, I started smoking dagga and cigarettes.

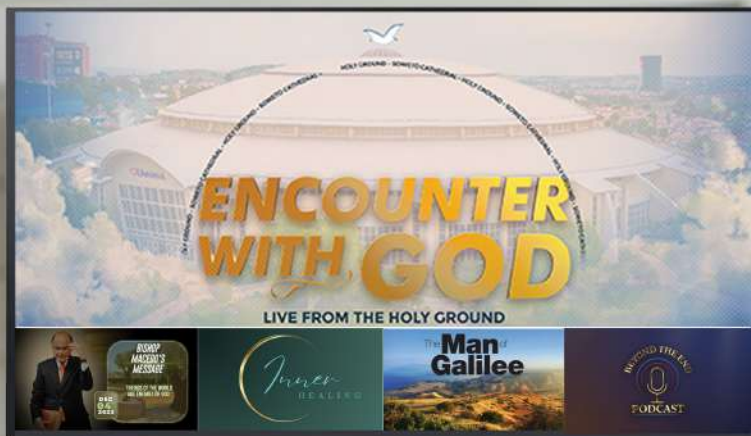
My mother invited me to attend services in the Universal Church, where I learned how to pray and put my faith into practice.

Years of Pain, No Answers


Vuyani thought his suffering would never end.

God healed more than my body. He blessed every area of my life. I am healthy, I have a blessed family. My life is proof that, with God, nothing is impossible.



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
