That is because one may have been saved long ago and is still saved today, but he will only remain saved if he is faithful until the end.

Many failed to remain faithful because they allowed their faith to be poisoned by feelings such as hurt, grudges or injustice.

We need to make every effort to remain in the faith, and we achieve this by consuming the Word of God regularly, engaging in consistent prayer, and surrendering our lives to God daily. Problems and injustices are inevitable in this unjust world, especially when one lives a righteous life. This is why we should always be vigilant and alert, so that we can protect ourselves from the devil's evil suggestions, which sow pain, resentment and the desire to obtain justice at any cost.

“But if our unrighteousness demonstrates the righteousness of God, what shall we say? Is God unjust who inflicts wrath? (I speak as a man).” Romans 3:5

A Broken Home

When Lerato's parents divorced, her father moved out and she was left with her mother, whom she deeply resented because she thought that her mother did not fight hard enough to keep their family together.

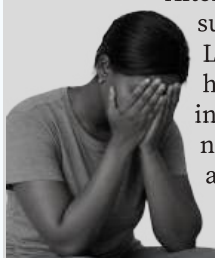
The hatred consumed her so much that she couldn't even stand being in the same room as her mother.

Searching for an Escape

Lerato turned to alcohol and pornography to numb the pain. Drinking led to blackouts and subsequent shame, which only deepened her sadness.

At her lowest point, she considered using a kitchen knife to harm her mother, and eventually drank an entire bottle of medicine, hoping to sleep and never wake up.

Torment Without Peace



After surviving the suicide attempt, Lerato started hearing voices that incessantly called her name, tormenting and driving her to desperation. She visited different

places searching for relief but found none.

Finding Rest

Her mother invited her to the Universal Church. The atmosphere in the church was different — people seemed genuinely at peace. When the pastor spoke about Jesus offering rest to those who are heavy-burdened, Lerato was drawn in. The prayers she received made a great difference because she slept peacefully for the first time that night.

Unshakeable Peace

Through the chains of prayers and other purposes of faith she took part in, Lerato let go of her anger, hatred and pain. She yearned to have God's presence inside her and sought this earnestly in prayer.

When it finally happened, she received a deep, unexplainable peace. It was as if God's love burst into her inner being and melted away all the years of anguish and hatred.

She went home and hugged her mother, for

whom she now felt warm love and affection.

Lerato's life is now a testament of the transforming power of God. She has overcome addiction and the deep-seated anger and hatred that once consumed her.

Word of God, I realised that I needed to humble myself and let go of my addiction.

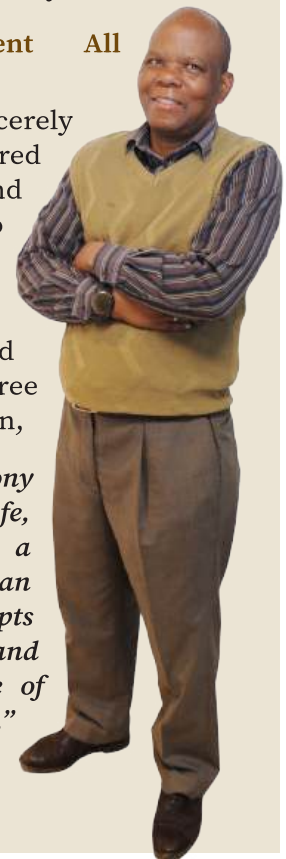
I started seeking the Holy Spirit because I knew that He was the only one who would transform my life completely.

A Void Left by Absence

When Bonolo's father disappeared from her life, she was left with rejection, emptiness, and no sense of worth.

Questioning God

Though her grandmother often spoke to her about God, Bonolo questioned His existence.

A Turning Point

When Bonolo received the Holy Spirit, God affirmed deep inside her that she was His child, and this was something she had always longed for — a loving and present Father.
